## California is all Vote-by-Mail

Is it different voting this election?

**YES!** You will have two ballots, one for the statewide primary and one for the Congressional District 1 Vacancy Election. Fill out both your ballots, place in correct envelopes, sign and date both envelopes.

What are the best ways to deliver my ballot?

- Bring your ballots to the next luncheon and we will deliver them directly to Oroville.
- Use a Ballot Drop Box
- Go to a Voter Assistance Center
- Mailing is also an option

Is it legal to collect ballots at our luncheon?

**YES!** The person taking the ballot must provide his/her name, his/her relationship to the voter, and his/her signature on the envelope for the voter whose ballot he/she is returning.

Should I wait until June 2nd to vote?

**NO!** Mail in ballots well ahead of election day. It may take days for the ballots to be received and recorded. **VOTE EARLY!**

How can I be sure the County Clerk/Recorder has my ballot?

Sign-up at [WheresMyBallot](#) to receive automatic email, text or voice call notifications about your ballot.

Can I still register to vote or check my registration status?

Yes, you may register up 15 days before an election or check registration status.

## ELECTION NOTICE

The Butte County Elections Division reminds voters that both the Statewide Primary Election and the Congressional District 1 Vacancy Election will be held on June 2, 2026. Ballot packets for both elections will be mailed out on May 4, 2026.

Each voter will receive two separate ballot packets, one for each election - the Statewide Primary Election will be in a **PURPLE** ballot packet and the Congressional District 1 Vacancy Election will be in an **ORANGE** ballot packet. Each packet will include an official ballot, a voter information guide, and a return envelope.

Please make sure each ballot is returned in the correct return envelope.
